Swissrail badges

Day tickets for visitors (cheapest option!)

• allow access during regular opening hours

- are valid on the day of validity as a ticket for the Berlin
- public transport are only valid for 1 day

A handling fee of CHF 0.05 is due per code. If the code is redeemed, costs of EUR 7.31 are incurred.

After ordering, you will receive an Excel file with the number of ordered codes. You can give the codes to your business partners, who can use them to create an entry ticket via InnoTrans website. Important notes:

- Make a note of who you have given which code to this is the only way to find out later who
 has accepted your invitation
- Each code can only be redeemed once be careful not to duplicate codes!

We will invoice you for the cost of admission tickets with the final invoice. Please place your order early. Orders placed less than a week before the show will have to be fulfilled separately and therefore we will have to charge you directly the more expensive handling fee of the show.

Do you no longer have the order link? You can retrieve it again <u>here</u>. Please note: The main contact of your company is stored with us. If you do not receive a link, please try the email address of the main contact.

Exhibitor badges

- are valid during the trade fair days (Tue-Fri) as a day ticket on Berlin's
- public transport system are personalized

Each co-exhibitor will receive 1-5 free passes (see below). Please order the total number of passes required. On the final invoice we will charge you only for the additional passes. Since each order at the fair involves a handling fee, we order the badges in bundles. You will therefore receive the codes with a delay.

After ordering, you will receive codes that you can use to personalize and download exhibitor passes on the Messe Berlin website.

Please order early. Orders less than one week before the fair we have to execute separately and therefore charge you the handling fee of the fair directly.

Restaurant

Travel to and from the fair

In principle, it is advisable to travel by public transport (S-Bahn), as there is often congestion around the exhibition grounds. The S-Bahn is also sometimes overloaded during the trade fair period. Expect an arrival time between 30 and 45 minutes.

Shuttle buses

There will be no hotel shuttles in 2022. Information from Messe Berlin about this:

Due to bottlenecks in buses and staff, we are unfortunately unable to offer a hotel shuttle at this year's InnoTrans. We kindly ask for your understanding. We will offer our other shuttles as usual. This includes the lines:

- Airport Shuttle à between exhibition grounds & BER Airport
- City Shuttle à between exhibition grounds & Zoologischer Garten
- M1 à between trade fair grounds & parking lot at Olympic

Square (also available during set-up and dismantling time)

We also recommend using public transport - all exhibitor and trade visitor tickets already include a ticket for the ABC fare zone.
